-Confirmation was received from Representative Moolenaar's office that the Village is awarded the \$1,646,000 for the Phase II expansion of the Industrial Park. Hud will be the clearing house for these funds.

-The "Inside-Out" Pavilion Project was approved by the Gratiot County Board of Commissioners on April 5<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$500,000 from the county ARPA funds. Thank you to our County Commissioners.

This open street event will permit the closing of the municipal parking lot and the consumption of alcoholic beverages in the municipal parking lot. The celebration will be on May 7, 2022 from 6-10pm. CARRIED.
